THE CRITERIA

- Demonstrated excellence, creativity and initiative in their organization, business or profession.
- Assisted others in reaching their full leadership potential

PROCESS

- 1. You can nominate for all categories but **one nomination per sheet.** More than one nomination per sheet results in an immediate disqualification.
- 2. The Juneteenth Subcommittee will initially screen all nominations based on the following:
 - o The nominator must complete ALL areas of the application.
 - o Nominee must accept the nomination.
- 3. Upon acceptance of nomination and completed nominator application, Nominator Application will be forwarded to a Selection Committee, consisting of a diverse group of leaders from the community.
- 5. Nominator Applications and Nominee Questionnaire deadline is **Friday**, **April 30**, **2019**.

The Juneteenth Committee will select the 2019 award winners in their respective categories and will be announced at the Juneteenth festival.

CATAGORIES

Academic Achievement: Students who have 3.0 GPA or above who strive for academic excellence.

Outstanding Athlete: One who is not only exhibit superior dedication, talent and skill, but also displays exceptional team spirit.

Perseverance: One who has remained focused while showing strength and patience to overcome a difficult situation(s).

Leadership: One who possesses integrity, vision, and dedication and who is exceptional in inspiring and empowering others.

Black Pride: One who expresses the proud heritage of the African American culture through his/her dress, conduct and/or spiritual persona.
